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


Fig 1. $^{99\text{m}}\text{Te-MAA}$ lung scan A : Pre LT* (1 year before, shunt ratio : 42 %) B : Post LT (5 Months after, shunt ratio : 6 %)

*LT: liver transplantation




Fig 2 Histopathological examination of second liver explant
