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Abstract

The Competence of International Student Advisor : from the point of view of supply and demand

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The purpose of this study was to examine the competence necessary for International Student Advisor from the point of view of supply and demand through the comparative analysis of the survey on expectations of international student advisor and the survey on expectations of international student.

The results showed that matched items on supply and demand such as including: “communication skills” and other nine types of abilities; “knowledge of immigration and other regulations which impact on international students” and other five types of knowledge; “had experience on international student advising” and other thirteen types of experiences; “fair” and other four types of attitudes. On the other hand, there are some wide gap between advisor and student on the point of view of supply and demand such as: “networking skills on human relations”, “recommendation to university and other institution on international student support system and acceptance policy”, including “short-term study aboard experience” and other six types of experiences; and including “kindness” and other four types of attitudes.
