— Self and others, and Chronotope in Bakhtin's theory —

In this research, we focus on the relationship between the narrative and construction of a self. This paper attempts to clarify the process of construction of a self through the personal narrative based on Bakhtin's work. Even though the idea that narrative constructs a self and reality is widely accepted today, the questions remain as to what kind of phenomenon it is to narrate oneself or how the content of narrative is related to reality. In this regard, Bakhtin shows the following viewpoints: the epistemology of self and others, and the relationship between the story world and the real world based on Chronotope. They give us a very important clue to reveal construction of a self through narrative.
