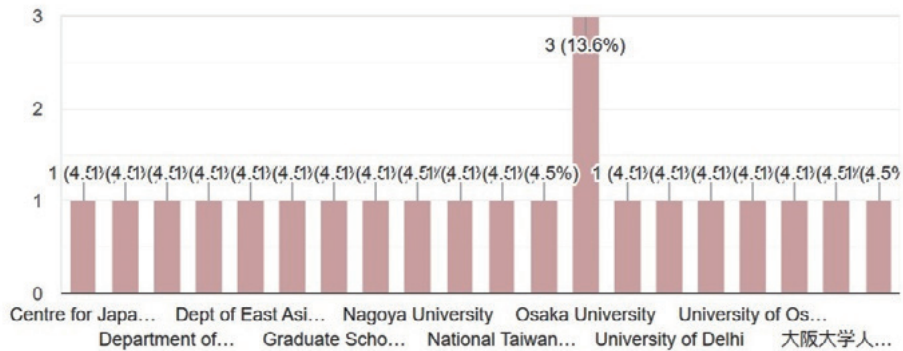

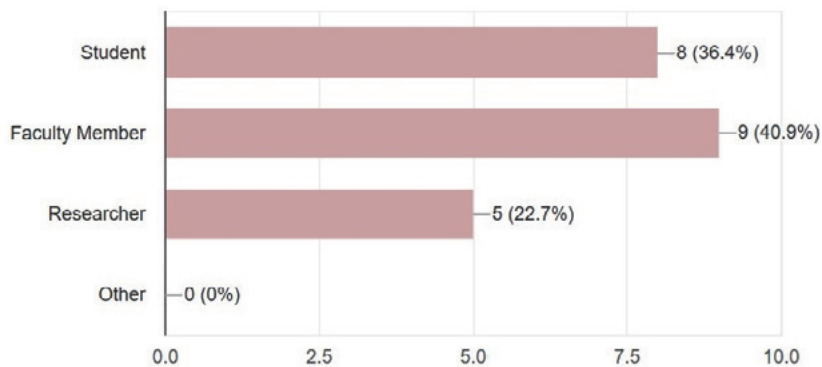

A Graph of participants' affiliation, category, and mode of participation

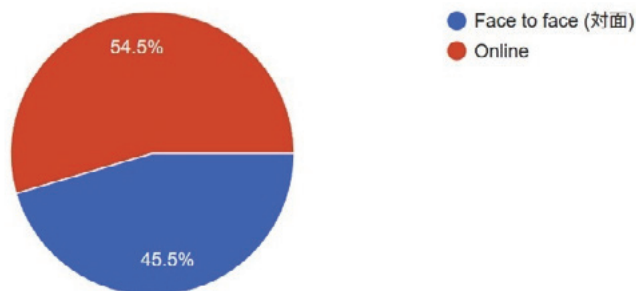

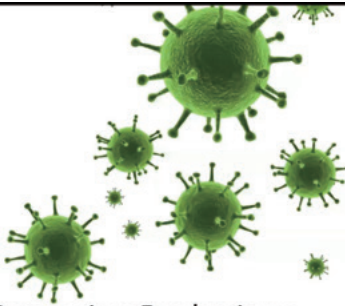
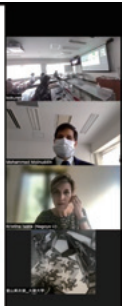


Mode of Participation



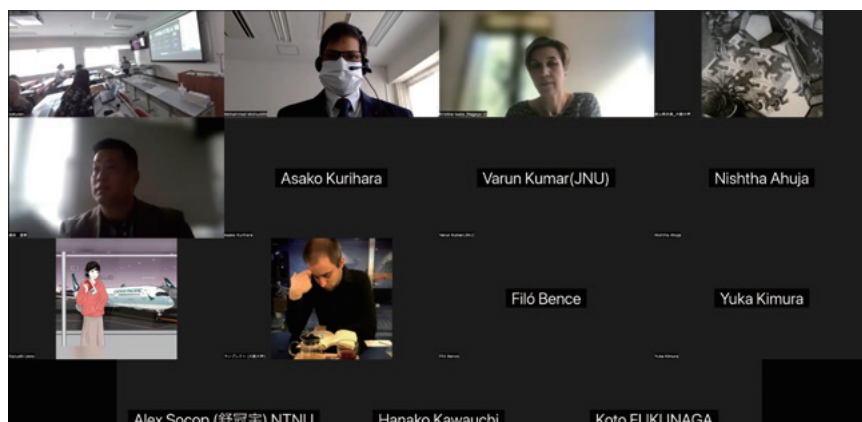

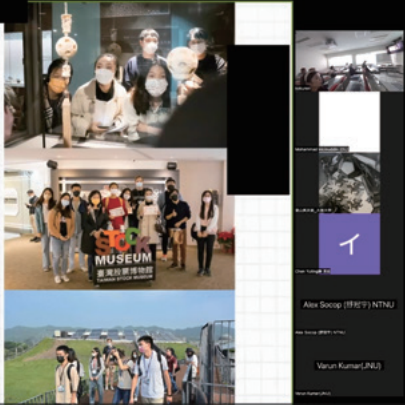
